

Get to Know Health PEI's Provincial Drug and Therapeutics (PD&T) Committee

Health PEI has a **Provincial Drugs and Therapeutics (PD&T) Committee** whose primary task is to make recommendations regarding all matters relating to medication usage throughout the province.

PD&T is a multidisciplinary committee whose membership includes Health PEI physicians, pharmacists, nurses, laboratory professionals, representatives from Clinical Information Systems (CIS), finance, a pharmacist from the Department of Health and Wellness, and a patient/family partner.

Quick Facts about PD&T:

- The committee is co-chaired by the Director of Pharmacy Services and a physician.
- There are several standing committees which provide recommendations to PD&T including the Oncology Subcommittee, Formulary Review Working Group, Parenteral Therapy Subcommittee, and the Antimicrobial Stewardship Subcommittee.
- Some responsibilities of the committee include:
 - Policy and procedure review, revision, and endorsement;
 - Evaluation of new and current drugs and therapeutics products;
 - Development and maintenance of the Health PEI Hospital Drug Formulary;
 - Providing recommendations to Health PEI regarding additions or deletions to the PEI Pharmacare Formulary;
 - Reviewing and approving order sets (paper based and electronic) which involve drug therapy.
