

Top 5 Patient Safety Incidents at Health PEI

At Health PEI, patient safety incidents are reported and tracked through the electronic **Provincial Safety Management System (PSMS)**. A **patient safety incident** is an event which could have resulted, or did result, in unnecessary harm to a patient/client/resident (Health PEI, 2021).

The Top 5 Patient Safety Incidents Reported in PSMS:

- 1. Falls
- 2. Behaviour events
- 3. Medication
- 4. Lab/Specimen
- 5. Safety/Security

Strategies to address top 5 incidents:

Policy revision/development Update of assessment tools Develop/review education/training QITs/committees identifying and addressing gaps (action plans)

Why Report Incidents?

- To learn from the event
- To focus on improvement and future prevention
- Promote a safe working environment
- Promote a "just culture"
 - A just culture is fairly balancing an understanding of system failure with professional accountability.
 - Also known as psychological safety, it is a culture where people believe they can
 question existing practices, express concerns and admit mistakes without ridicule or
 punishment.

The primary role of incident reporting is to promote patient safety by focusing on system improvement and a just culture.
