

What are Required Organizational Practices (ROPs)?



Required Organizational Practices (ROPs) are essential practices that organizations <u>must</u> have in place to enhance patient/client/resident safety and minimize risk.

Examples of ROPs include:

- Falls Prevention and Injury Reduction
- Client Identification
- Hand Hygiene Compliance
- Workplace Violence Prevention

There are <u>31 ROPs</u> Health PEI must have in place

What are High Priority Criteria?



High Priority Criteria are standards related to safety, ethics, risk management, and quality improvement. These standards are the next level from the ROPs.

An example of a high priority criteria is Health PEI having an ethics framework.
