

What is Patient Safety?

Patient Safety is the reduction of risk and prevention of harm to patients/clients/residents receiving health care (Canadian Institute for Health Information [CIHI], 2016; World Health Organization [WHO], 2021). Focusing on patient safety is fundamental to delivering quality care and services.

Quick Facts on Patient Safety:

- 1. In 2019-2020, 1 in 18 hospital stays in Canada involved at least one harmful event (CIHI, 2021).
- 2. Medication errors are the leading cause of injury and avoidable harm in health care systems (WHO, 2019).
- 3. At least 1 out of every 7 Canadian dollars is spent treating the effects of patient harm in hospital care (WHO, 2019).
- 4. Patient safety incidents are the third leading cause of death in Canada (Canadian Patient Safety Institute, 2020).
