QUALITY IMPROVEMENT TEAMS

Quality Improvement Teams (QITs) are multidisciplinary groups dedicated to advancing the safety and overall quality of care across Health PEI (HPEI).

These teams identify opportunities for improvement within their specific program area and lead initiatives to enhance care delivery and service standards. QITs also play a key role in maintaining Accreditation Canada and other relevant standards.

HOW MANY QITs DOES HPEI HAVE? WHAT AREAS DO THEY COVER?

HPEI has **24** QITs. Many of these teams are program-based, such as Surgical Services, Home Care, and Pediatrics. Others span multiple areas of care, including Medication Management and Infection Prevention and Control.

WHO ARE THE MEMBERS ON A QIT?

QIT membership typically includes Unit/Program Managers, Clinical Leads, Educators, Supervisors, Physicians, Quality Patient Safety Consultants, Health Analytics Support, Patient and Family Partners, and Frontline Staff.
