



REQUIRED ORGANIZATIONAL PRACTICES (ROPs)

Accreditation Canada and Health Standards Organization (HSO) work together to advance the mission of improving health care quality and safety. HSO develops standards and Accreditation Canada applies them through the accreditation process.

Health PEI (HPEI) will be evaluated using **six core (mandatory) standards**: Governance, Leadership, Medication Management, Infection Prevention and Control, Emergency and Disaster Management and Service Excellence. In addition, **19 service standards** will be assessed, reflecting the various programs and services offered across our organization.

Embedded within these different standards are **Required Organizational Practices (ROPs)**.
