EARLY PHASES OF STROKE CARE

The **Acute Ischemic Stroke Care Pathway** contains the essential components for the early phases of stroke care – *Emergency Phase, Post Thrombolytics, Acute Care Phase* – including:

- Assessment (Observations/Measurements)
- Diagnostics/Laboratory
- Treatments/Interventions
- Medications
- Mobility/Activity
- Patient Safety Cues
- Nutrition
- Consults
- Psychosocial Support/Education
- Transition Planning
