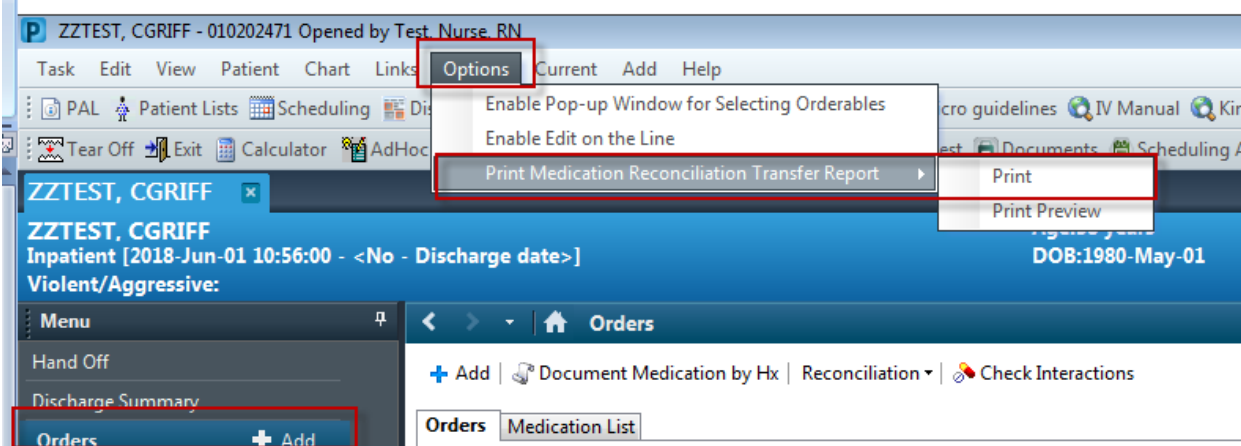

- traZODone** 50 mg, Oral, bedtime, Tablet
