PowerChart Updates:

New Acute Inpatient Mental Health Suicide Risk Assessment Tool - There is a new assessment tool to be used for Acute Care Inpatient Mental Health patients.

This tool **will not** replace the Suicide Risk Estimation tool as it is to be used **only** on Unit 9 QEH, Inpatient Mental Health PCH and at Hillsborough Hospital.

Staff using this tool have received training and can follow up with their educators regarding workflow.

The form is located in the assessment folder in Ad Hoc charting.
