### **DISPLAY OF URINALYSIS RESULTS**

Urinalysis results will display differently depending on whether the test was completed by the Lab or by staff using the POC analyzer in the ED. See images below:

#### **Lab resulted Urinalysis:**

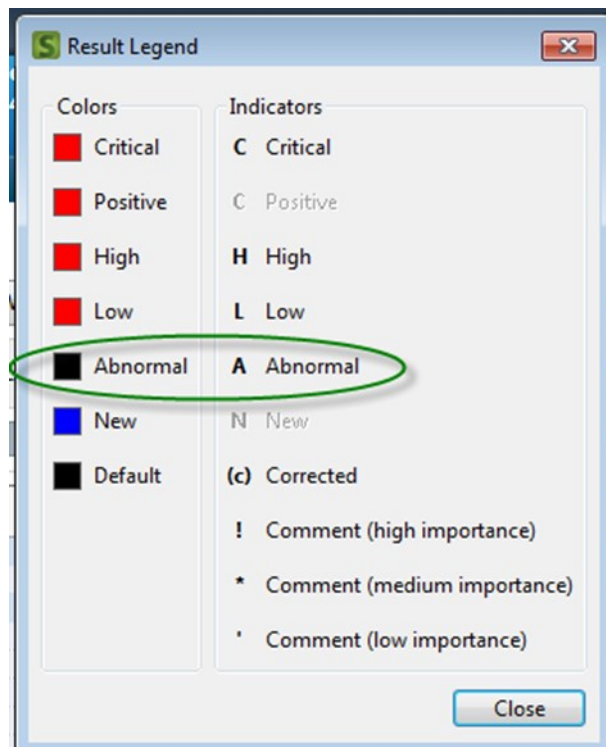
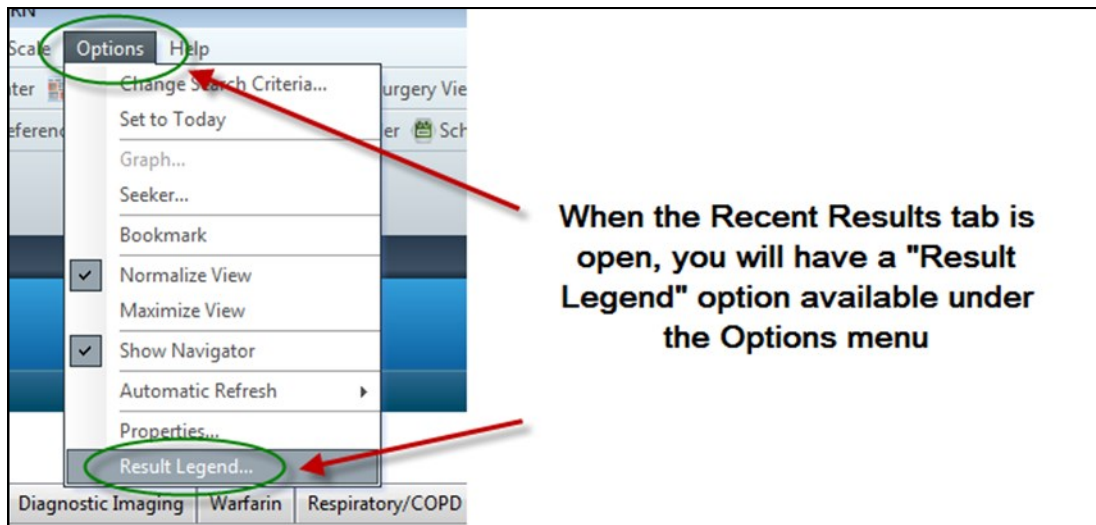

**Only abnormal protein results will display in black font with the preceding "A" if the POC machine is used. All other abnormal (and normal) urinalysis values will display in blue with no preceding "A".**

Once all facilities have the new POC analyzers in place, urinalysis results will display consistently with all abnormal values resulted in **black** font with a preceding **"A"**, regardless of where the urine was analyzed (Lab, ED, etc).

## Results Legend



The Results Legend can be used as a guide to explain the different colors and preceding letters often found on lab results within patient charts.
