

Charting Diluents

Adding the diluent and diluent volume in the charting window will push these results to the I & O tab.

Note: Premixed medications will automatically have a diluent and diluent volume in the charting window.

To chart a medication that has been diluted by a nurse:

1. Single click the task to access the medication charting window.
2. Compare the medication you have administered against the order details in the task window.
3. Choose the appropriate diluent.
4. Enter the volume of diluent.
5. Enter any additional information that is pertinent. (ie: infused over time).
