

## Charting a PRN Response

The system will populate a PRN Response for certain PRN medications (ie: pain, nausea/vomiting).

The PRN Response task will display on the MAR, Care Compass, LaunchPoint and Task List:

PRN tasks will fire after administration time:

1. Oral, IM and Subcutaneous medications – 30 minutes
2. IV – 5 minutes

Under the Care Compass click on the Activities column

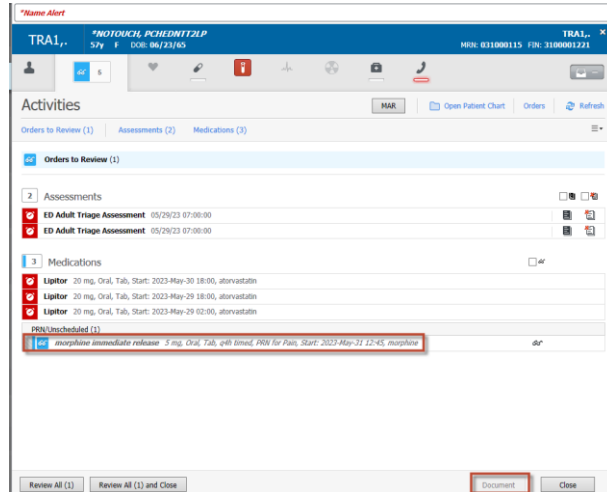

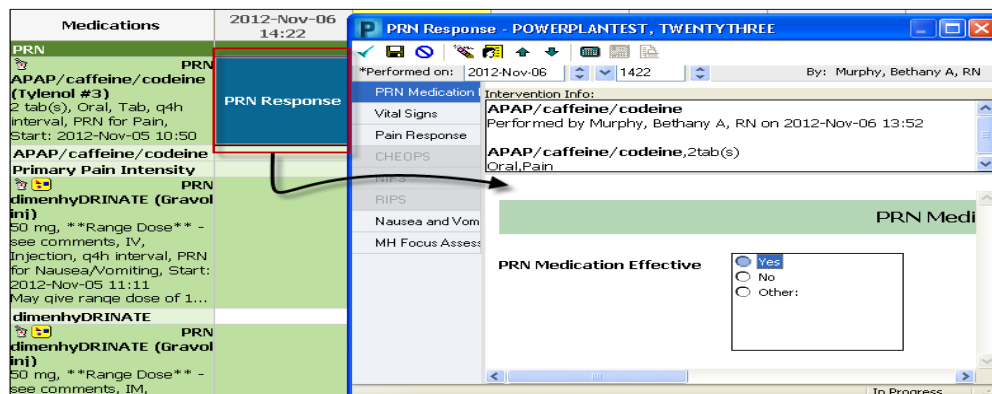
To chart a PRN Response intervention click in the task and the PRN form will open:
