

Scheduling/Surgical Procedures Classification on Orders Page

Inpatient Orders for Ambulatory Departments


To place an order for your inpatient to have an appointment with an ambulatory service within the hospital, you would;

- verbally request the ward clerks to call and make that appointment.(as you would today)
 - scheduling clerk will then book the appointment.
- the appointment will display in the Orders page under the classification of "Unspecified" with the status of Future (On Hold)




When the patient arrives for the procedure;

- the Scheduling Clerk will "Check In" the patient
- the appointment will now display under the classification of "**Inpatient**" with **Ordered** as the status indicating that the requested procedure was done.



A Surgical Procedure your patient is booked for will also show here under "Surgical Procedures".



- The appointment will display in the Orders page under the classification of "Unspecified" with the status of Future (On Hold)

- After the patient is checked in ,the appointment will display under the classification of "**Inpatient**" with **Ordered** as the status indicating that the requested procedure was done.
