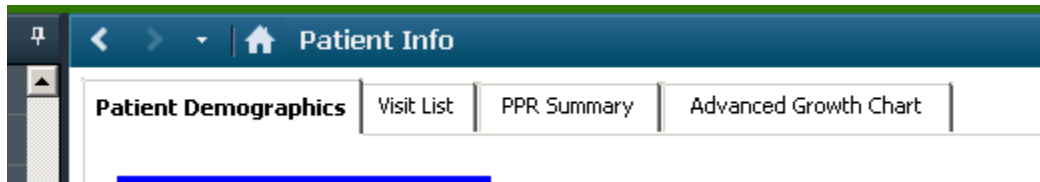


Patient Information Tab

The Patient Information tab consists of multiple sub tabs:

- Patient Demographics
- Visit List
- PPR Summary (Patient/Provider Relationship)
- Advanced Growth Chart



Patient Demographics Tab

Displays general information regarding the patient including:

Name of the patient

Address

Telephone number

Religion

The information populated on this screen is entered/controlled by the Registration Department.

Visit List Tab

The top section of this screen displays a list of the patient encounters (visits) including the admission and discharge date, facility, location, medical service, encounter type and reason.

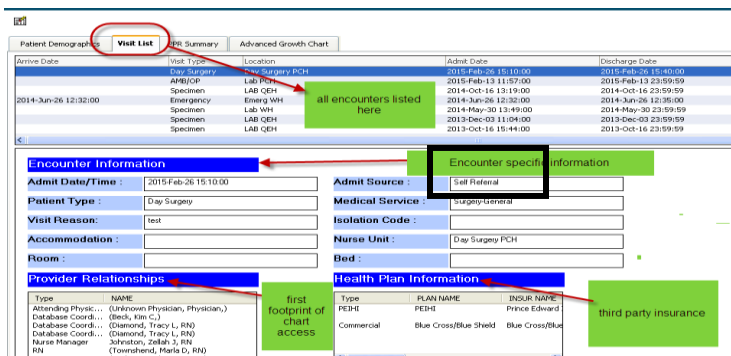
- The most recent encounter is viewed at the top of the list.
- Another encounter can be selected/opened by double clicking on the desired encounter
- **Ensure the correct encounter is selected to open.**

When the clinician **double clicks on a desired encounter** a message box will open that says **“This will change your patient’s chart to another encounter.... Do you wish to continue?”**

Selecting **“Yes”** will automatically open the selected encounter.

NOTE: There is the ability to document on any encounter

Be careful to document on the correct encounter!!!



The bottom section of this screen contains information specific to the selected visit. Some common types of information include

- The provincial health number (MRN/PHN),
- The admission date and time
- Providers during that visit.

Patient Provider Relationship (PPR) Summary Tab

Top section **“Lifetime Relationships”** displays name of family physician or Nurse Practitioner

Lower section of screen, **“Visit List”** provides more details about the clinician accessing the chart for this encounter, including:

1. Clinicians Name
2. Relationship

3. Date last in chart (Begin Date)

Advanced Growth Chart

The growth chart will open automatically to default settings.

- Information is populated to this screen from data entered in chart
- This chart is sex and age (Birth – 20 years) specific.
- Growth charts for females display in red
- Growth charts for males will display in blue.
- CDC (Center for Disease Control) and WHO (World Health Organization) charts are both available
