

PowerPlans


- A PowerPlan is identified by the  icon.

It is a grouping of orders that are typically ordered together for a particular condition, situation or plan of care


- **A PowerPlan has the ability to:**

- Prevent duplicate ordering by more than one provider. Discontinue the orders in a plan individually or all at once.
- Proactively plan the patient’s care before the orders need to be activated (place orders in a planned state); for example, ordering a post-operative PowerPlan with orders for post-surgery before the surgery occurs.

PowerPlan Icons


Symbol	Description
	Merge View - Allows proactive duplicate checking
	Show Only Selected Items - Removes any orders you have not chosen from the screen for easier viewing.
	Discontinue - Discontinuation of a Plan
	Add to Phase - Allows orders to be added to the Plan quickly
 Initiate	Initiate - Activate Plan orders
	Expand & Collapse (Details Pane) - Click the up arrow to reveal order details for the item you have selected. Click the down arrow to collapse the pane.
	Including & Excluding Orders . Allows each provider to customize the plan of care to meet the individual patient’s needs
	Order Details Not Complete : Indicates that there are required order details that have not been completed for the orderable and must be completed in order to initiate the plan.


There are several functions in PowerPlans you may use:



Set this option to show only the selected items in your PowerPlan.

This feature can be used prior to signing the PowerPlan to better facilitate ordering.

If you are satisfied with the orders you are placing, Select Orders for Signature



Allows additional orders to be added, to the PowerPlan from the orders page.
