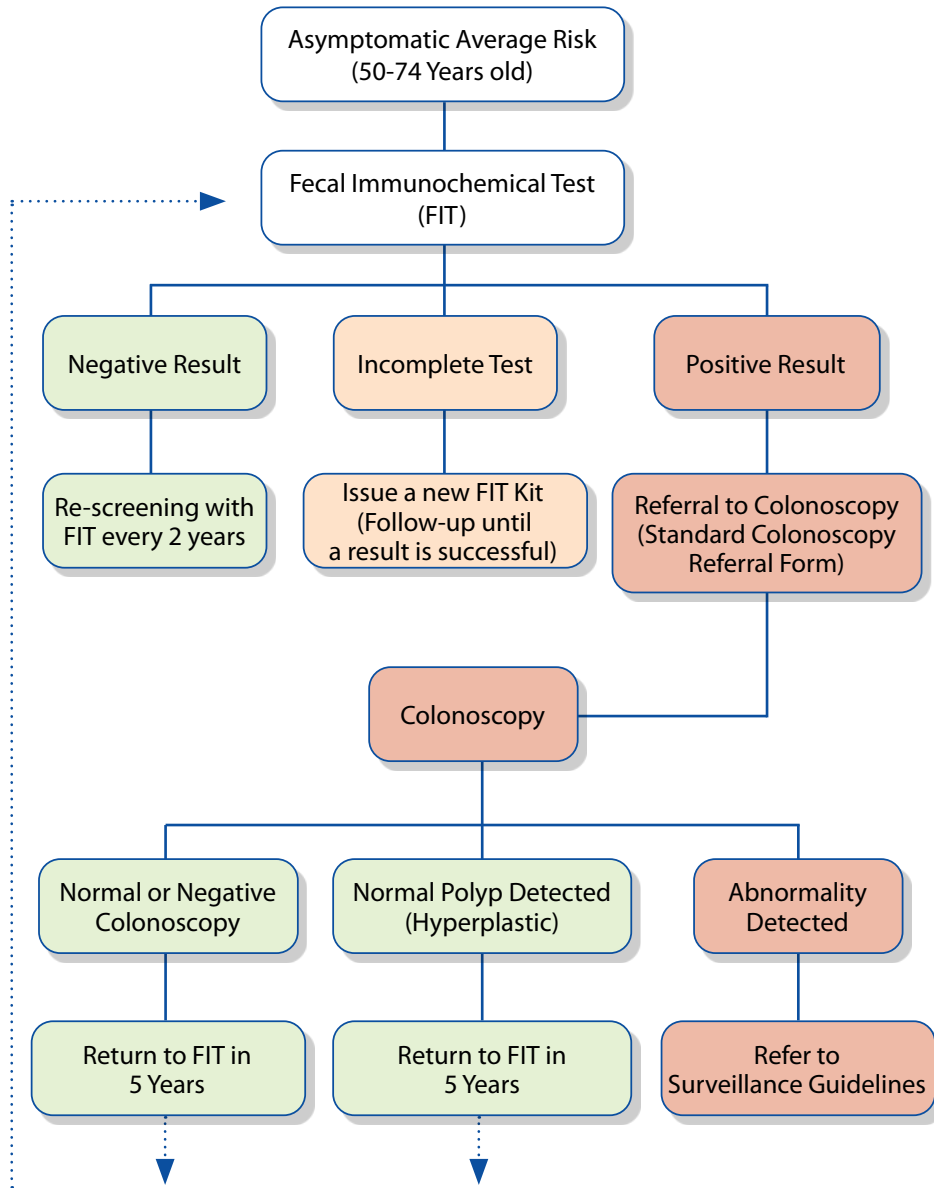

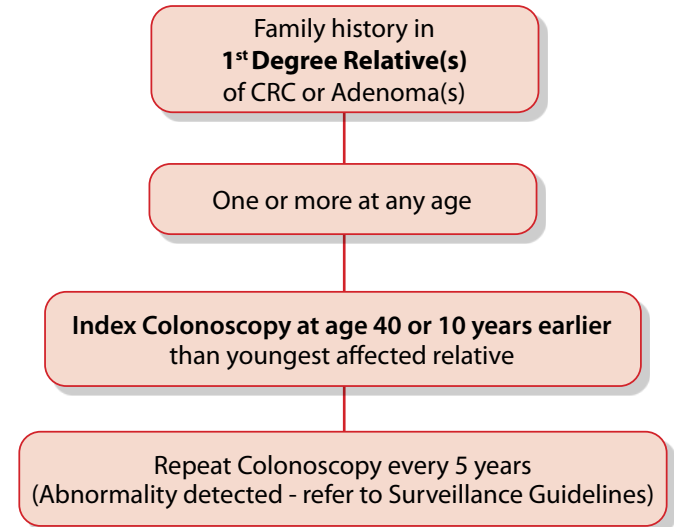
Average Risk



COLORECTAL CANCER SCREENING PATHWAY

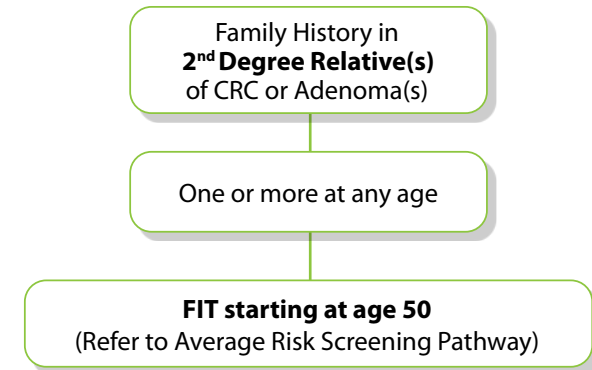
Increased Risk

COLORECTAL CANCER SCREENING PROGRAM

FIT Kit Request Calls

1. Are you between the ages of 50 – 74 years?

Yes proceed to next question.

No They are outside the age of the screening program. They should speak with their physician or nurse practitioner if they feel they need screening.

2. Have you had a colonoscopy in the last 5 years?

Yes They do not need screening until colonoscopy routine is finished or 5 years from last scope.

No Proceed to next question

3. Do you or your immediate family have a history of colon cancer, cancer of the bowel?

Yes They are at an increased risk and need to speak with their physician or nurse practitioner. They may need a colonoscopy following the pathway inside this brochure

No Proceed to next question

4. Have you completed a stool sample (FIT) to test for blood in stool in the last 2 years?

Yes FIT testing is recommended every 2 years; they do not need screening now. They should speak with their physician or nurse practitioner if they feel they need screening.

No Hand out a FIT testing kit or get address details to mail the kit
