

## Provincial Preventative Diabetes Foot Care Program

FAQ for Providers

### WHAT IS INCLUDED?

This is a free foot care service that includes:

- Foot and nail assessments by a foot care nurse
- Nail care, callus care and corn care
- Education and promotion of self-care or caregiver provided care
- Education to prevent common foot issues
- Professional advice on when medical attention outside the ability of the program is needed

### WHAT IS NOT INCLUDED?

- This is not a wound care clinic. Foot care nurses cannot provide any care below the surface of the skin.
  - No complicated ingrown toenails
  - No wounds
  - No infections
- This is not a Diabetes Education Centre.
- There are no physiotherapy or fall prevention services.

### WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

To be considered for the program clients must:

- be diagnosed with diabetes
- be able to travel to the clinic site
- be able to get into the foot care chair independently
- have a moderate, high, or stable high risk based on the [Provincial Diabetes Foot Screen](#) performed by a referring provider
- based on client's self-report, have a lack of sufficient insurance coverage for individuals with moderate risk (less than 80% of footcare needs - \$50/appointment at eight appointments a year)
  - Note: high and stable high risk will be seen regardless of insurance status

A health care professional is required to make the referral to the program.
