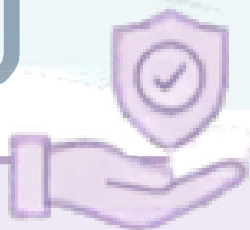




DID YOU KNOW?

Information About Alcohol Based Hand Rub



- Infection Prevention and Control has **approved (PURELL®)** as the hand hygiene product for Health PEI.
- Alcohol based hand rub dispensers must be located at **point of care for ease of use.**
- Point of Care includes but is not limited to: **point of patient/resident care, nursing stations, medication preparation areas, multiuse devices, entrances to facilities/units, break areas and public areas.**
- A new refill cartridge must be used each time the product runs out. This reduces the risk of contamination of the product.
- Containers/dispensers of alcohol-based hand rub, soap and lotion must never be reused or topped up.
- IPAC approved products are standardized to align with Infection Prevention and Control and Accreditation standards.
- Only healthcare grade hand lotions and creams should be used when at work; to ensure that they do not interfere with the effectiveness of Purell.
