As Health PEI slowly begins the ease back of regular practices, operations within Provincial Laboratory Services will also slowly be reinstated.

The return of service operations has to be done in a coordinated and safe manner for our patients. As restrictions are lifted, we still have to be mindful of social distancing. For our area, this is very challenging when large groups of patients present to our locations for procedures.

To address this situation, the PCH laboratory will have to strictly adhere to booked appointments only.

Set appointment times enable our services to manage patient visits. Appointments will be used to ensure our waiting room does not present a health risk to our patients in opposition to the social distancing requirements set forth by the Chief Public Health Officer.

We do realize that this change in practice will affect operations as we have in the past provided services when patients presented without an appointment. We ask for your patience as we navigate through this new course.
