

**Submission Form for Tick Identification through eTick.ca**

Health PEI is partnering with eTick.ca to identify ticks found on people, animals or the environment in PEI.

Islanders can take pictures of their ticks and submit them directly to eTick.ca or through the free app available through the Apple App store or the Google Play store.

Occasionally, eTick.ca will direct submission of the tick to a local laboratory for further testing and will provide an eTick identifying number. This number must be submitted to the local laboratory along with the tick.

For laboratory submissions (**only as directed by eTick.ca**):

- 1) Ticks should be placed in a small ziplock type bag or small clean container (like a pill bottle);
- 2) Label the bag/bottle with your eTick.ca referral number and submitter's name.
- 3) Submit the completed form and the tick to any hospital laboratory on PEI



## Submission form for Tick testing

Health PEI has asked eTick.ca to direct any person with an *Ixodes scapularis* tick (formerly known as the deer tick) to be submitted to a hospital laboratory for potential further testing as a representative sample used to monitor tick borne diseases on PEI. If this occurs please follow the laboratory tick submission process noted on the previous page.

If you have signs or symptoms of a tick borne disease, please seek health care attention.
