





COVID-19 AND INFLUENZA (FLU) VACCINATIONS

Health PEI is recommending that all staff receive this years **updated** COVID-19 and Influenza vaccinations. We use the word "updated" to describe these vaccines because they are expected to be updated on a yearly time frame as the viruses change year to year.



The goal of these vaccines is to protect against spread, severe illness, hospitalization, and death. They also restore and enhance protection from previous immunizations, which has declined over time.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q. When is the best time to receive the Influenza vaccine?

A. Influenza season in Canada usually begins in December, but can start as early as October. It takes most people 2 weeks after vaccination to build protection against influenza infection. Your Employee Health Nursing Team began offering the COVID-19 and Influenza vaccines in October.

Q. Am I eligible for COVID-19 vaccine?

A. You are eligible to receive a COVID-19 vaccine if it has been 6 months, with a minimum of 3 months, since your last COVID-19 vaccine, or your last COVID-19 infection.

Q. Can I receive both the Influenza and COVID-19 vaccines at the same time?

A. It is safe to receive both the Influenza and COVID-19 vaccines on the same day.
