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PROFESSIONAL SERVICE REIMBURSEMENT UPDATE

Effective February 28, 2025, reimbursement requirements for “**Prescription Adaptation**” and “**Therapeutic Substitution**” services will be updated. These services may be performed by a PEI pharmacy participating in Pharmacy Plus for a resident of PEI with a current PEI health card. Please note the changes to the reimbursement framework for these professional services on the Resources for Community Pharmacies webpage at <https://src.healthpei.ca/resources-community-pharmacies>.

Please note that there has been no update to the reimbursement framework for “**Refusal to Fill**” service. For reimbursement eligibility of this service, the patient must be enrolled in one of the applicable PEI Pharmacare Drug Programs and the medication must be a benefit of the drug program for which the patient is enrolled. The medications considered are limited to prescriptions for **narcotics, controlled drugs, and targeted substances**. Early refills/part fills (where patient orders refill/part fill early, lost or stolen medication) are not eligible for reimbursement of this service.
