<ul> <li>Set up</li> <li>Thinking in advance.</li> <li>Is this Okay</li> <li>Hope for the best, prepare for the worst</li> <li>Benefit for patient/family</li> <li>No decisions necessary today</li> </ul>	Understanding	What is your understanding now of where you are with your illness
	Information Preferences	How much information about what is likely to be ahead with your illness would you like from me? For Example: Some patients like to know about time, others like to know what to expect, others like to know both.
	Prognosis	Share prognosis as a range, tailored to information preferences.
Guide (right column)	Goals	If your health situation worsens, what are your most important goals?
	Fears/Worries	What are your biggest fears and worries about the future with your health?

· Affirm commitment	Function	What abilities are so critical to your life that you can't imagine living without them?
· Make recommendations about next step		
· Acknowledge medical realities	Trade-offs	If you become sicker, how much are you willing to go through for the possibility of gaining more time?
