Reminder: Where to Document Historical Injections in the EMR

We are sharing clarification regarding the correct location for **documenting historical injections** in the EMR.

It has come to our attention that some users are entering historical injection information under **Patient Data → Preventive Care → Imported**. This field is **not intended for documenting injections** and can affect reporting accuracy.

Correct Workflow

All historical injections including those administered outside your clinic must be documented under:

Injections → Check the “Historical” box

This ensures:

1. The information is visible to all providers in the correct clinical location
2. Reporting tools that rely on historical injection data remain accurate
3. Consistent documentation standards across the EMR

Why this matters

Accurate documentation of historical injections is important for both data collection and clinical usability.

When historical injections are entered under *Imported* instead of the **Injections** section, the information is not captured in the correct data field. This affects how the EMR collects reports from immunization data and may lead to inaccurate results in analytics or clinical reports. Documenting historical injections

in the **Injections** section also ensures that other providers can efficiently locate this information when reviewing a patient's immunization history.
