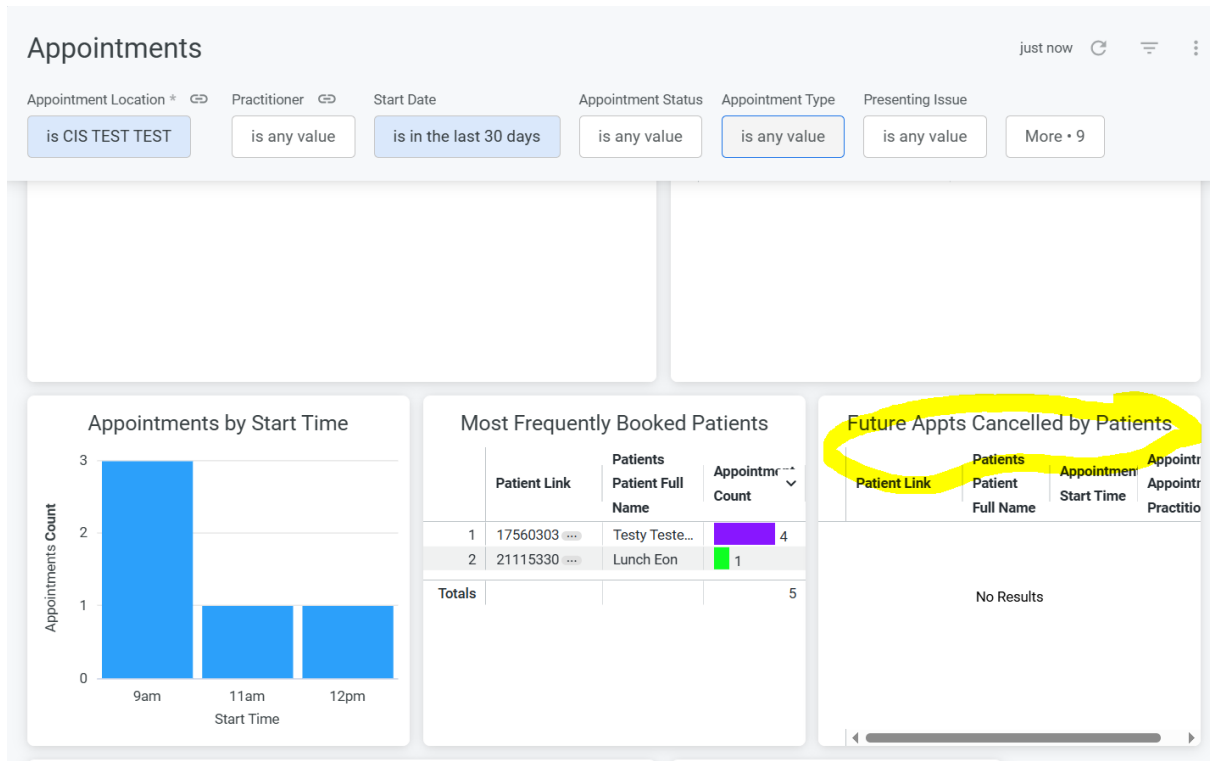


CHR Notification – PEI Provincial EMR Communication – May 12, 2025

Future Cancelled Appointments

Patients have the ability to cancel their appointments; however, notifications are not sent to clinics when patients do cancel. For clinics to be aware of cancelled appointments, a dashboard has been created in Analytics to offer a way to check and see if the clinic has any appointments affected by this kind of patient-initiated action in advance. It is suggested to run Analytics a minimum of 1x / week to monitor openings in schedules.

Prescription Settings


Would would remind staff who have access to the **Prescription Settings**, please ensure that the **Medication List** set to **Vigilance Santé** is **NEVER** altered.
