

## Framingham Reference Guide

You can access an automatically calculated Framingham score using Patient Embedded View.

The Framingham calculates based on several data points located in the patient chart:

**Age:** Calculated from Date of Birth

**Sex:** Pulled from Sex field, which represents Sex at Birth

**HDL-C and Total Cholesterol:** Pulled from Lab Results. The ordering practitioner or primary practitioner must have e-results turned on for this field to populate. Will pull the most recent result.

**Systolic Blood Pressure:** Pulls from the latest vitals.

**Hypertension Treated:** A medication that treats hypertension must be listed under the patient's medication section of the chart for the patient to be considered treated.

**Smoker:** To be set to Yes, the patient must have one of two fields populated:

- 1- Social History Record under Health Profile  
Type: Substance Use  
Sub-type: Smoking  
Status: Current Smoker (daily), Occasional (non daily), Smoker, or Current Smoker with attempts to Quit
- 2- Social History under Patient Data (which can be added to the chart header)  
Status: Current every day smoker, current someday smoke, or Smoker.

**Diabetic:** Patient must have a diagnosis listed under their Health Profile that starts with 250.\*\*
