## **Professional Development Subcommittee**

There is a Professional Development Subcommittee of the Provincial Stroke Steering Committee whose purpose is to a) determine the needs of health care providers who work with stroke survivors, b) prioritize these needs and develop/coordinate education events to address the needs, c) develop an annual professional development plan, and d) administer the provincial stoke bursary (funding to support attendance at professional development opportunities). This subcommittee meets quarterly to carry out their work.

## Local Conferences/Workshops/Education Days

There are conferences/workshops/education days held annually on PEI which may be either inter-professional or profession specific. Examples of these would be – Provincial Stroke Conference, NDT workshop for therapists, Cognitive workshop for Occupational therapists, etc. There may or may not be a cost associated with the event.
