SUBJECT: Glucose Sensor Program – product addition

Effective August 27, 2024, the PEI Glucose Sensor Program will expand to include the **Medtronic Guardian™ 4 sensor** and **transmitter**. This new sensor will be available to eligible patients under the Glucose Sensor Program in addition to the already available Medtronic Guardian 3 Sensor.

Please note the following:

• The **Medtronic Guardian™ 4 sensor** and **transmitter** will <u>only</u> be compatible with the MiniMed[™] 780G insulin pump model.
