




Updates to Clinical Content - iVIEW

Methotrexate Frequency Rule:


Methotrexate 5 mg, Oral, Tab, Daily:



For any frequency other than Today, Once, Unscheduled, Sunday, Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, Friday, Saturday, q7days, the frequency alert

Single dose range alert:

Methotrexate 35 mg, Oral, Tab, Wednesday



If the dose is greater than 25 mg per single dose, the dose range alert fires.

Dose Range Alert:

Age: >= 18 years Routes: Oral, IM, Subcutaneous

Dose range type: Single

From: 0 mg To: 25 mg

Methotrexate 35 mg, IM, Injection, Wednesday

The wording of the alert has been customized for each route:

Oral: Used in rheumatology or oncology indications

IM: Used in rheumatology, oncology or ectopic pregnancy

Subcutaneous: Generally, only used in rheumatology





New Duplicate Anaerobic Therapy Alert



For active inpatient orders there will be an alert if metronidazole is combined with carbapenems, piperacillin-tazobactam, or amoxicillin-clavulanate. Prescribers will be given the option with the alert to cancel or continue with the order.

Dose Range/Frequency Checking for Methotrexate Oral



Methotrexate 35 mg, Subcutaneous, Injection, Wednesday
