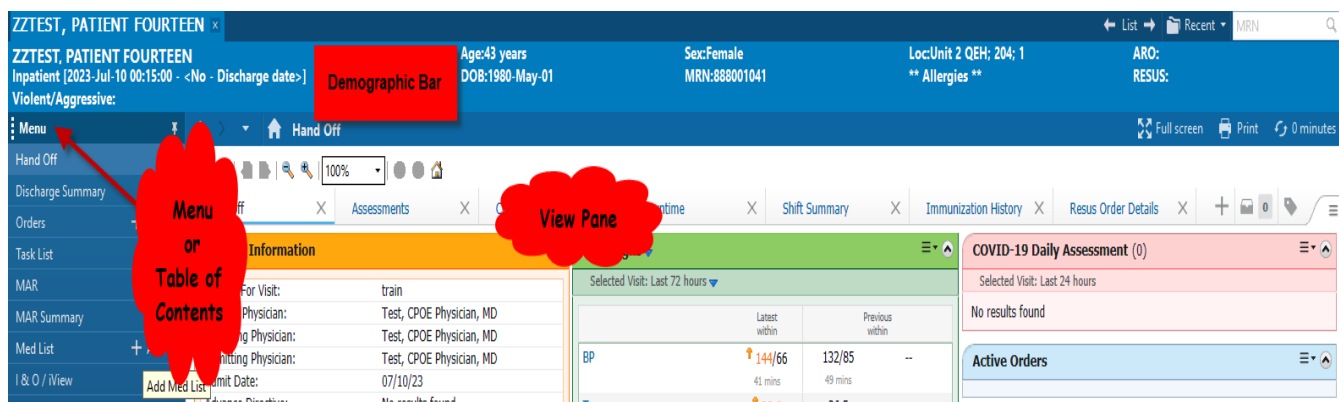


## Chart Overview

- Sections of the chart include:
  - ✓ Demographic Bar
  - ✓ Menu or table of Contents (TOC)
  - ✓ View pane



- View only: Hand Off, Pending Referred Out Lab Tests, Overview, Review Chart, MAR Summary, Results Review, Form Browser, Med List, Patient Info, Transfusion Summary Report, Lab Collections Summary, Patient Schedule
- Data entry: (Assessments, MAR, I&O/View, Orders, Task List, Documents, Allergies, Histories, Problems and Diagnoses)
- Encounter specific
- Displays patient information








**Demographic Bar:** Contains basic information ( Name, DOB, ARO, Age, Location, Resus Status etc)

Information pulls from Registration details, Physician Orders (Resus Status) and Alerts and information entered by Nursing ( ARO, Violent/aggressive and allergies )

**Menu or Table of Contents (TOC):** Contains list of folders that house pertinent encounter specific information entered by clinicians

**View Pane:** Detailed information, found in a selected folder from the Menu, will display

## PowerChart Icons available within the Chart View

	<b>Patient Search</b> – opens the Patient Search dialog box to enable you to search a patient's chart and / or a specific encounter.
	<b>List</b> – Opens the next chart on a patient list. The chart will open to the same page ( for example the MAR)
	<b>The Recent icon</b> – When selected displays the last 5 patient charts that you have accessed. A chart can be opened, by clicking on the name.
	<b>Print</b> – Prints the current window. <b>Printing is strongly discouraged.</b> Only the providers current patient list may be printed.
	<b>Refresh icon</b> - Refreshes the info on the screen that is open. Screens must be refreshed separately.
	<b>Menu Tack</b> - will expand or collapse the TOC
	<b>Forward/Backward Arrows</b> - Allows clinician to move back and forth between last two screens opened
