


# **Building Custom List:**

To begin building a patient list:


- 1. Click on Patient Lists tab
- 2. Click on the List Maintenance icon from the menu bar . This opens the Modify Patient Lists dialogue box.




- 3. Click **New** to activate the patient list maintenance wizard.
- 4. Choose Custom from the list. Click Next.








6. Click the location from the Available lists to highlight it. Click the to move the list to the Active Lists box.



#### How to Add to a Custom List:

### Option 1:


 With a Location list open, right click on the patient name. Choose the appropriate list.



Click Refresh. The patient name will on the custom list.

#### Option 2:


1. In the Patient List, click on the Add Patient icon. The search window opens. Enter the MRN. Click on Search button.



- 2. Click on patient name and add the patient.
- 3. Refresh your screen and the Patient will be added to your list.

## Option 3:


1. With the patient's chart open, click on Patient on the Tool Bar.



- 2. Choose Add to Patient List
- Select your custom list

#### How to Remove a Patient from a Custom List:

- 1. Highlight the patient name on the list.
- 2. Click on the Remove Patient icon.



3. Refresh your screen and the patient will be removed from the list.

# **Deleting Custom List From the Patient List Tab:**

- 1. Click on **Patient Lists** tab.
- 2. Click on the List Maintenance icon from the menu bar . This opens the "Modify Patient Lists" dialogue box.

- 3. If the patient list you wish to delete appears in the "Active Lists" column, you must first move it to the "Available List" column.
- 4. Highlight the patient list on the active list column.
- 5. Click on the arrow to move it to the "Available List" column.



- 6. Right click on the list you wish to delete.
- 7. Select "delete patient list". You are asked if you permanently would like to delete this list.
- 8. Select "yes".
- 9. The List is now deleted from the Available Patient Lists window
