

## Problems and Diagnoses Tab

### Diagnoses (Dx)

- Are Encounter specific
- Are the responsibility of the attending physician
- The “Display” should be set to “**Active**”
- Can be viewed, entered (using the “Add” button) or modified (using the Modify button) within this tab
- The display will include: Clinical Dx, the date entered, and the Dx type (admitting, working or discharge)
- If patient is not discharged the display will be an admitting or working Diagnosis
- If patient has been discharged there will be an “Admitting” and a “Discharge” diagnosis display

### Problems

- Will carry from encounter to encounter
- Are the responsibility of the nurses caring for the patient
- Is a list of problems the patient is actively being treated for
- The Display should be set to “**ALL**”
- If the patient has no chronic problems, there is an option to select “No Chronic Problems”
- Chronic problems may be:
  - Added using the “Add” option
  - Modified using the “Modify” option
- “Mark all as Reviewed” documents the information was reviewed for this encounter
