


Transfusion Summary Tab

This tab:

- Is maintained by Canadian Blood Services
- Contains historical information on the blood products the patient has received within the previous seven (7) years in P.E.I.
- Identifies patient blood group and RH (Group/Type)
- Identifies any Antibodies the patient may have
- Includes products received outside of acute care settings (Win Rho administered in doctors offices)
- Provides product information including: Unit Number, product name, volume, status(transfused or stopped) and date transfused



BLOOD PRODUCTS TRANSFUSION HISTORY REPORT
Do not place on patient's chart, report may be updated at any time

If Rh Positive Plateletes are transfused to a Rh Negative patient, Rh immune globulin (WinRho) may be indicated .The standard dose of WinRho (300 mcg) will protect an Rh negative patient for up to 6 platelet doses (pools), or up to 2 months (whichever comes first).
