

Professional Consult Orders

General rules:

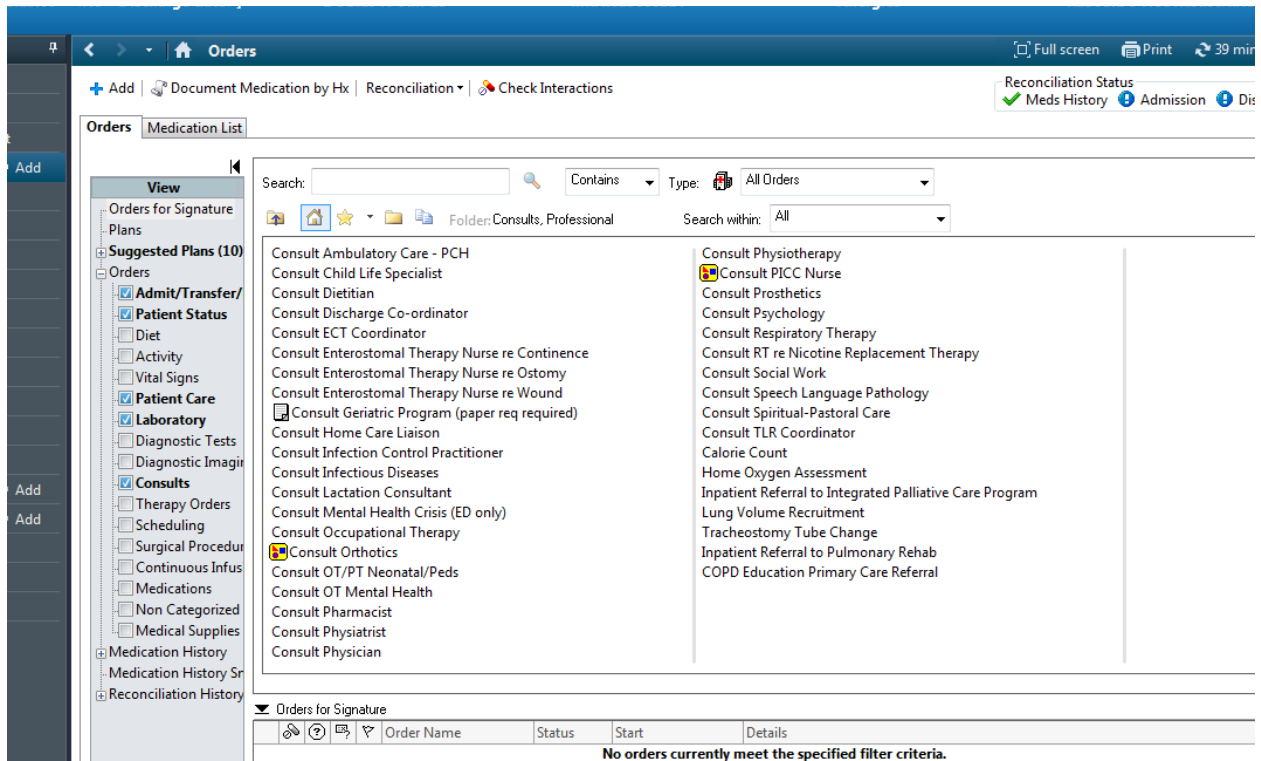
- Each facility has a different process for consults to professionals
- Physician consults may have a requisition online, but ALL physician consults require a phone call or face to face request

Ordering online/requesting a service:

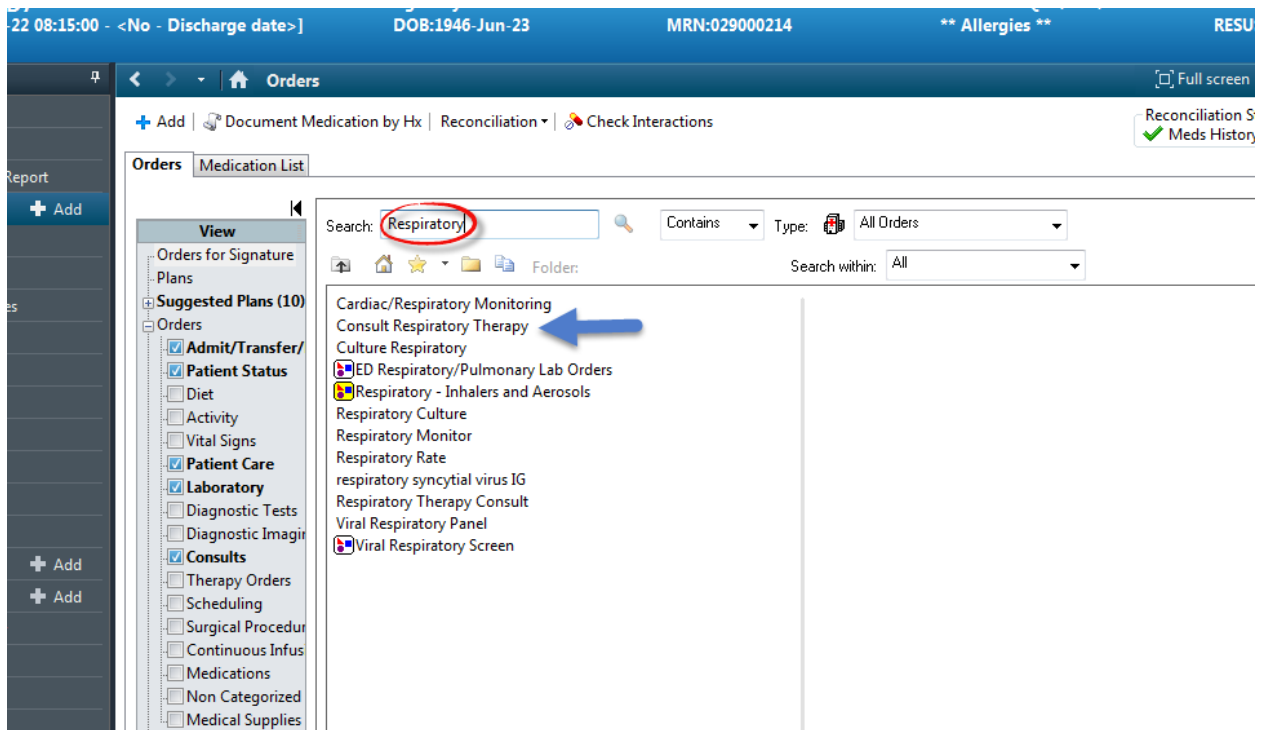
- Go to the orders page on the grey navigation bar
- From the home page, use the search field or open the ' Consults, Professional'

A Special Note about the order to 'consult a particular physician'

- Most physicians do not have a list generated by CIS for consult orders
- A phone call is required
- The consult order provides easily accessible information for the consultant
- The consult order is a record of the intention to consult, but without the correct process of a phone call, the consultant is not likely to respond
