Privacy Matters Corner...



Protect yourself and your patients! It is important to log into and out of your CIS account each time you are accessing CIS or leaving the computer. Leaving your account logged in when you are not at the computer can give someone else the ability to fraudulently use your account and you would potentially be held accountable for their actions. It is also against policy and contrary to user agreements to use someone else's account, it can cause problems with the accuracy of patient records and

we are legally required under the Health Information Act to ensure we are keeping accurate records. Protecting your password, the integrity of your charting and patient's information is a requirement for all and can be as simple as logging into and out of the system. If you have difficulty remembering to log in and out, it might help to make a reminder for yourself such as a sticky note on the edge of the computer screen or a note left on the mousepad.



Creation of two new note types for Nephrology: Nephrology Clinic Consult and Nephrology Clinic Note






PowerChart/FirstNet/SurgiNet Updates: (continued)

Nephrology Update (continued)

These note types can be found under 'Physician Clinic Documentation" Folder and subdivided into two categories "Nephrology Clinic Consult" and "Nephrology Clinic Note"



Reminder - Patch Orders:

Each time an order is entered in the system with a route of "Transdermal", the system places a "Patch Remove" order automatically with a frequency of "Daily" and the name of the orderable in the order comments.

Nursing may need to modify the frequency on this order for the "Patch Remove" task to fire at the correct time
