RE: Rhlg Administration Form

To help provide the best care for obstetrical patients in PEI, your office has been issued several doses of RhIg. As RhIg is a blood product, the PEI BTS is required to document to whom each and every dose was given.

Currently, your office provides this information to us by filling in the blue transfusion tag attached to the product and returning it to us. Occasionally, however, tags can be lost or forgotten. When this happens, it can be quite a lot of work for the office to determine – after the fact – who was given a particular dose of Rhlg.

In addition to returning the transfusion tags, the PEI BTS recommends that you consider attaching the Rhlg Administration Form to your fridge and documenting when staff remove doses of Rhlg from the fridge. In the event that a transfusion tag is lost / misplaced, the information recorded on this form will make it far easier for you to determine which patient received the dose.
