



In February 2013, bar-coded MRN wristbands were implemented to help improve positive identification of patients during Point of Care glucometer testing. The data included in the above chart was collected during a 1 week period prior to bar-code implementation and 1 week post implementation with a total of 2,657 results being evaluated.
